## Scholarship and Awards Procedures

Additional information may be requested by specific departments. For performance scholarships, students should contact the specific department (music and/or athletics). Returning students should reapply for scholarship and awards each year.

Applicants are encouraged to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). The FAFSA determines financial need which is used to award various scholarships.

Most scholarships require the recipient to be enrolled as a full-time student, 12 semester hours or more.

Award Program recipients must be enrolled in 12 or more credits. Enrollment in on-line, correspondence, or collaborative courses may affect the award(s).

**TRANSFER STUDENTS:** All transfer students should complete the scholarship and awards program application and must include a copy of their college transcript.
