Canadian Application for Form I-20 and Certification of Financial Responsibility

IMPORTANT:

The information on the following pages explains how to become eligible for F-1 student status in the United States.

The Form I-20 is a multi-purpose document issued by a U.S. government-approved educational institution certifying that a student has been admitted to a full-time study program and has demonstrated sufficient financial resources to stay in the United States. The Form I-20 allows an individual to apply for an F-1 student visa at a U.S. embassy or consulate abroad. You need a Form I-20 to obtain an F-1 student visa or status, or to keep lawful F-1 status when transferring or changing schools within the U.S.

These steps must be completed at the same time as you are applying for admission to Minot State University.

INFORMATION REGARDING ACCEPTABLE SOURCES OF FINANCIAL SUPPORT

Your financial support can come from any combination of the following sources in the U.S. or abroad:

- 1. **PERSONAL FUNDS** that come from your own resources, not those of your relative.
 - a. Savings and/or investment statement(s) in your name. The most recent statement of balances and deposits that is available. Statements cannot be more than 2 months old at the time you submit your statements.
 - b. Scholarships, Grants or Loan(s) in your name. Attach a copy of your award letter and/or contract.

Note: Minot State University is an eligible school for the receipt of Canada Student Loans. Student loan applications are available online starting in June of each year at <u>canlearn.ca</u>. It can be difficult to use loans as proof of support prior to acceptance.

2. FUNDS FROM "SPONSORS" (parents, relatives, friends). Unless you have sufficient funds to support yourself for your entire program of study, you will need a sponsor with an income sufficient to support you. You may have as many sponsors as you need.

a. FINANCIAL SPONSOR(S) AFFIDAVIT OF SUPPORT (page 7 of this packet).

i. This form may be photocopied for each sponsor. **All** questions must be answered.

b. DOCUMENTARY EVIDENCE OF FUNDS AVAILABLE. (instructions on page 6) i. Savings, investment, retirement or education fund statement(s)

3. OTHER SOURCES OF FUNDING such as scholarships, graduate assistantships, loans or other sources.

- a. COPY OF YOUR SCHOLARSHIP AWARD LETTER, GRADUATE ASSISTANTSHIP CONTRACT OR LOAN TERMS stating <u>exactly</u> what you will be receiving and for how long.
- b. Minot State academic scholarships cannot be used towards proof of financial support

DOCUMENTS THAT CANNOT BE USED TO PROVIDE FINANCIAL EVIDENCE:

- **1.** Discretionary income
 - a. We will **not** accept tax returns, pay stubs or letters of employment
- 2. Business income
 - a. Bank statements/letters must be for an individual and **cannot be under a business name**, even if the individual is self employed
- 3. Screen shots or photos of computer, phone or tablet screens will not be accepted

*This is the minimum amount of guaranteed funds you must document in order to be issued a Form I-20. Portions of this amount cannot be removed to create a lower amount, even if you are living off campus. Financial proof of the full amount is required by the federal government.

On-campus employment is extremely limited and competitive, and off-campus employment is strictly controlled by U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services.

Expect annual increases of approximately 10% each year.

Financial Sponsor's Affidavit of Support

WHAT DOES THIS AFFIDAVIT MEAN?

By completing this affidavit, you are swearing to the U.S. government that you will provide this student with a specific amount of money from your own financial resources *for every year* the student is going to study at Minot State University and live in the U.S. You are also proving that you can afford the support you are promising with the documents you have attached.

HOW TO COMPLETE THIS FORM:

- Fill this form out completely in English. Promise only the amount of money you are able to give.
- Attach documents that provide evidence of support

ALL DOCUMENTATION YOU PROVIDE US MUST BE:

- 1. Less than two months old at the time of submission of documents.
- 2. In English.
- 3. Photocopies or faxes, not originals. (The student will need originals for their entry into the U.S.)

DOCUMENTS THAT PROVIDE FINANCIAL EVIDENCE OF FUNDS AVAILABLE:

Savings, investment, retirement or education fund statement(s)

- a. The most recent statement that is available, which shows balances and deposits.
- **b.** If the statement is in the name of more than one person (example: husband and wife), each individual must sign the affidavit of support.
