

How to Register for Core Academic Skills for Educators Tests

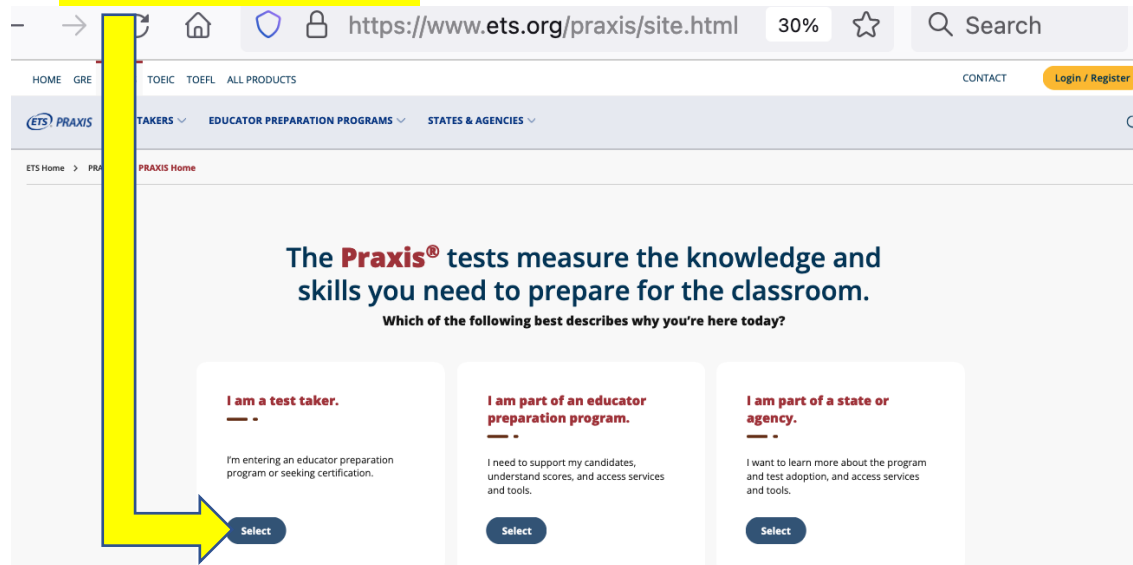
You will need:

- A debit card, credit card, or PayPal is needed to pay for the test(s). Interest-free payments can be made using PayPal:
\$90 each x3 ← Recommended. Can take on separate days and pay separately; *OR*
\$150 for combined ← Not recommended. 5+ hours of testing at once
- To create a username and password (a safe place to store)
- Your personal and MSU class calendar/planner to schedule your chosen date(s)
- Also, take time to prepare. Further information begins on page 6.

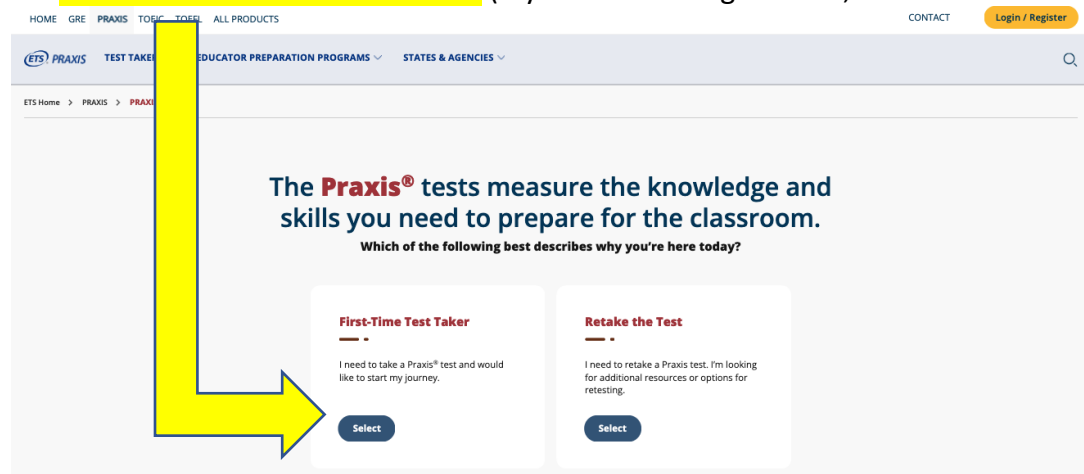
1. Go to the ETS website provided here:

Important: Some states require a Social Security number (SSN) in order to process certification paperwork. Check your state's requirements to see if your state requires a SSN with your test score reports. ETS does not require your SSN for its own purposes, but will submit it to your state agency with your test results. Failure to provide your SSN could delay your state's processing of your certification application.

Please provide a valid e-mail address. Order confirmations and test admission tickets will be e-mailed to this address. Be sure to add @ets.org to your address book or safe sender list to ensure that you receive e-mail messages from ETS.

“Test at Home” tips:

- Be advised → you must have a computer with space to download the proctor material (it takes quite a bit of space).
- You must have a photo ID available.
- You must use a small dry erase board (or transparency sheet) and dry erase marker rather than scratch paper for the math exam.
- You must have a clean working area (no clutter) and sit with your back toward a door (think of computer charger/extension cord).

NOTE:

Your MSU advisors strongly suggest you take each test on separate days unless you are a strong test taker. To register for each test individually, you must select only one of these three → continue to schedule and payment. REPEAT for the second test. REPEAT for the third test.

If you choose to take all three on the same day, select the “Core Combined” directly below (the yellow box in this picture shows it).



*Core Academic Skills for Educators (CASE)
Mathematics Review*

We want you to be prepared and reach your goals!

Many students must retake the CASE math test because they have not properly prepared and reviewed the material. This costs you time and money.

Use the *"CORE" Math Made Easy* book by Dr. Lynn Gardner to prepare for the specific concepts covered in the CASE mathematics test including: Number and Quantity, Algebra and Functions, Geometry, and Probability and Statistics.

You may purchase the book at www.mgmtutoring.com (electronic or hard copy) or a used version at another website of your choice. There are limited books on reserve at the library for you to check out and the Tutoring Center has books to use when visiting the center.



The best strategy to prepare for the test is to:

1. Start reviewing the book the semester before you plan to take the test.
2. Work the problems included in the book.
3. Visit the Tutoring Center, Old Main 103, during CASE Math Test Prep hours, found on the tutoring schedule at www.minotstateu.edu/cet/peer_tutoring.shtml.
4. Ask questions and review any problems you find difficult. (Be aware that others may be using tutoring services. We appreciate your patience and ask that you plan your time accordingly.)
5. Try practice tests on your own to check for understanding.
